

Fully qualified French Teacher (Kindergarten - Grade 8)

The German International School is a private school in the West of Toronto. The GIST is part of the network of over 140 German schools abroad and is therefore funded by the Federal Republic of Germany and regularly reviewed for quality development. Our school will be attended by about 80 students in the upcoming school year. The children of our school come from Germany and all over the world and are taught from kindergarten to eighth grade. As a German school abroad, we work according to the Thuringian curriculum, which is supplemented by the Ontarian curriculum. Classes are cross-year and competence-oriented. German and English are spoken in everyday school life.

To strengthen our team, we are looking for a motivated and fully trained French teacher who will take over our French classes in Kindergarten, primary and middle school starting May 2, 2022. The contract is to be continued in the new school year. Ideally, you will be taking over a two-hour French Club for class 1/2 in the afternoon as well.

Area of responsibility:

With the advertised position you will take on a part-time position at the German International School Toronto. You will be responsible for all French lessons at the German International School Toronto. You will be teaching class levels from Kindergarten to grade 8. In addition, you will take over the management of our weekly French club for class 1/2 in the afternoon. You will organise French lessons in small groups for different and individual levels. You will work with performance-differentiating textbooks and digital teaching materials to design and plan the lessons. You take over the leadership of the French department at the GIST. You will have a total of 18 teaching lessons.

Requirements for this teaching position:

- You have passed the first and second state exams (or equivalent) in primary and secondary education.
- German is ideally your mother tongue. Please also submit your application if you are a native French or English speaker.
- Your teaching is competence-oriented, individualising and language-enhancing.
- You have a high degree of flexibility to adapt to different levels of learning and to encourage and challenge them accordingly in a differentiated and individualising way within lessons in small learning groups.
- You have a high level of communicative competence, which enables you to respond to the different concerns of our German and Canadian families.
- You will enrich the class teams within the joint planning and preparation and will take on further tasks reliably, responsibly and independently, which will enrich the school development.
- You have experience in the area of “digital learning” and sound knowledge in working with common communication platforms and various digital learning platforms such as Seesaw.
- You will regularly take part in training courses offered.
